STATUS CONFERENCE REPORT

Defendant and Cross-Complainant City of San Buenaventura (City) submits this status conference report (Report) in advance of the status conference scheduled for September 20, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. On September 8, 2021, the City emailed a draft of this Report to all parties who have appeared and invited input and joinder. The City did not receive any comments other than the joinder of Meiners Oaks Water District and Ventura River Water District reflected on the signature page. Consistent with the Court's instructions, some parties may submit their own status conference reports.

1. EXPERT DISCLOSURES

Pursuant to the Court's scheduling order, on August 31, 2021, the City served the following:

- Expert Witness Disclosures;
- Declaration of Christopher M. Pisano;
- Claire Archer, Ph.D. and Tamara Klug's Expert Witness Report, Technical Memorandum and Exhibits 1-149;
- Douglas R. Littlefield, Ph.D. Expert Witness Report and Exhibits 1-60; and
- Charles H. Hanson, Ph.D. Expert Witness Report and Exhibits 1-22.

The State Water Resources Control Board, California Department of Fish and Wildlife, California Parks Department, Casitas Municipal Water District, City of Ojai, the East Ojai Group, and the Proposing Parties (Ventura River Water District, Meiners Oaks Water District, Wood-Claeyssens Foundation (Taylor Ranch), and Rancho Matilija Mutual Water Company) shall serve their expert disclosures, including expert witness reports, by September 24, 2021, unless otherwise ordered by the Court.

2. DRONE FOOTAGE OF WATERSHED

In June and July of 2021, a drone operator obtained footage of twenty-four locations throughout the Ventura River Watershed. The City will circulate the video footage to all parties and will host a Zoom meet and confer meeting to discuss the footage and any objections in the coming weeks. The City and Proposing Parties hope to present the final video at the October 2021 status conference.

3. ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE REGARDING SERVICE BY PUBLICATION

At the August 16, 2021 status conference, the Court set an Order to Show Cause hearing for September 20, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. regarding service of the City's Third Amended Cross-Complaint by publication of the summons as to heirs and devisees of certain deceased Cross-Defendants, and two unserved Cross-Defendants located behind gates and fences in the *Ventura County Star*.

The City provided notice of the OSC to Ole Behrendtsen and Shanks Investments Group LLC via overnight mail to each site address and hand delivery on Secretary of State on behalf of Shanks Investment Group LLC on August 24, 2021. On September 9, 2021, the City received Ole Behrendsten's signed notice of acknowledgment of receipt. The City will submit the required proposed order to the Court for approval of service by publication on the heirs and devisees and service via delivery to the Secretary of State for Shanks Investments Group LLC on September 20, 2021

4. REQUESTS FOR ENTRY OF DEFAULT

The City has submitted approximately 1,380 request for entry of default, in a first phase of requests, submitted in sixty-nine (69) groups of approximately twenty (20) parties each.

Approximately 780 defaults have been returned as entered. The Court is currently processing approximately 600 pending requests. Once the Court has entered the pending 600 requests and in cooperation with the Court, the City will file a second round of requests for defaults, which will constitute approximately 500 additional requests for entry of default.

5. ELECTRONIC SERVICE

On August 5, 2019, through the filing of their Joint Initial Status Conference Statement, the parties stipulated to request that electronic service by 5:00 p.m. be deemed same day personal service. On October 2, 2019, the Court ordered that all papers filed or lodged with the Court are to be served on File & ServeXpress by the party that generated the paperwork, in conformance with Code of Civil Procedure section 839. The City has been unable to locate an order regarding the request regarding electronic service in the August 5, 2019 Joint Initial Status Conference Statement. Thus, the City requests an order from the Court that electronic service on File & ServeXpress by 5:00 p.m. be deemed same day personal service for the purpose of calculating court deadlines.

6. CONCLUSION AND SUMMARY OF REQUESTS

The City respectfully requests that the Court consider taking the following actions at the September 20, 2021 status conference:

- Issue an order for service by publication at the OSC.
- Issue an order that electronic service on File & ServeXpress by 5:00 p.m. be deemed same day personal service.
